- My father taught me.
- Thank you. I went to the hairdresser's yesterday.
- No, she's gone out. (*now*)
- I liked it when I was young but now it's terrible!
- I washed it a few minutes ago
- I baked these biscuits last night, if you want one.
- Have you seen it? (*now*)
- Yes, that's how the thieves came in.
- The police have arrested two men! (*recent happening*)
- I've cut my finger! (*recent happening*)
- There's been an accident! (*recent happening*)
- I went to see a great film last Saturday!!
- No, thanks. I've just had lunch. (*just*)
- I've just arrived from a long journey. (*just*)
- I've already posted it. (*already*)
- He's already left. (*already*)
- We went to Greece for a holiday.
- To the disco but last Saturday evening I stayed at home.
- He's gone to Spain. (*He's there*)
- She has been to Italy. (*She's back*)
- No, I didn't play. I studied for my history test.
- Oh, it rained continuously so we didn't go outside.
- Her English has improved.
- The film was very boring – don't go to see it!
- The price has gone up.
